Danger, adventure, romance and discovery await those who flee the Rebellion. Lives are overturned, hardships are faced in the wilderness, daunting refugee problems are encountered in El Paso, and all of the characters are forced to make hard adjustments to their lives. Much of the action is based on real events and locations.
